



Saskatchewan Technology Fund Expression of Interest (EOI) Template

Confidentiality Clause

1. All information in any format supplied by the applicant to the Ministry of Environment and/or Innovation Saskatchewan (ENV/IS) regarding the applicant or the subject matter of the application, whether identified as confidential or not, shall be:
 - (a) used by ENV/IS only for the purpose for which it was supplied; and
 - (b) held in confidence by ENV/IS and shall not be disclosed by ENV/IS, except
 - (i) to the extent required by law;
 - (ii) to its employees on a need-to-know basis; or
 - (iii) to third parties engaged by ENV/IS to review, assess or advise ENV/IS with respect to the applicant's application or matters directly related thereto.
2. If ENV/IS discloses the applicant's information to its employees or to third parties, ENV/IS shall ensure that its employees or third parties are subject to the same confidentiality requirements as ENV/IS.
3. Notwithstanding 1 and 2, although ENV/IS will require its employees, third party consultants, advisors, and service providers to hold the applicant's information in confidence to the same extent as ENV/IS, ENV/IS shall not be responsible for or liable to the applicant for any unauthorized or improper disclosure of the applicant's information by ENV/IS employees, third party consultants, advisors, or service providers.
4. The obligations specified in paragraphs 1 and 2 do not apply to any information that:
 - (a) is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or becomes publicly known through no breach of this agreement;
 - (b) becomes known to a party from sources having the right to disclose such information;
 - (c) is approved for disclosure by written authorization from the party that originally furnished the information.

EOIs will be evaluated based on alignment with the Saskatchewan Technology Fund program's eligibility criteria. Only shortlisted applicants will be notified and invited to submit full project proposals. Applicants must use this template to develop an EOI for their project application as a first step to applying for Saskatchewan Technology Fund funding. EOIs not using this template will not be accepted.

Eligibility: To apply for funding, the applicant must meet the following mandatory criteria:

- You must be a regulated emitter with an established baseline under *The Management and Reduction of Greenhouse Gases (Standards and Compliance) Regulations, 2023*.
- You must have the authority to submit this EOI on behalf of the applicant organization.
- You must confirm the information in this EOI is accurate and complete.

The EOI documents are subject to *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FOIP) and are governed by the Government of Saskatchewan Record Disposal System.
